Firearms Permit: Prepare for the State Firearms Permit through BSIS. Training requires classroom instruction and range qualification. **Proof of citizenship is required to Obtain a Firearms Permit.** The handgun safety class is given on Monday and **Firearms Permit continued:** Tuesday along with the Firearms Permit class. This class satisfies the requirement for the Handgun Safety Certificate through the Department of Justice.
